




## Trinity in the West Mission Area

A WELCOMING COMMUNITY that is accepting of others who are different,


✤a place to experience GENUINE RELATIONSHIPS that help us grow,





#### Are we unique among Episcopal churches?




86% of Trinitarians agree that we are **friendly** & welcoming, **fun-loving** & food-oriented.


